SAMAN DECK WASH DWA100

DESCRIPTION

Saman Deck Wash is a powerful cleaner that is specially formulated to restore the natural color to severely weathered and discolored wood.

-concentrated water based formula

-fast acting (10-15 minutes)

-restores wood's natural color and beauty

-removes stains from dirt, mildew, algae and fungus

-use before waterproofing or staining: decks, fences, outdoor furniture, exterior wood and wood plastic composite

Solids: 5 ± 0.5% (by weight)
Density: 1.01-1.02 kg/l
Coverage: 300-400 sq. ft/gal.
VOC: 0.4% (by weight)
Recommended applicators: synthetic bristle brush or roller
Clean up: Clean tools with soap and water.
Storage: Store in a cool, dry place. Freeze-thaw stable (if frozen, thaw completely before using). KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.
Shelf life: at least 1 year in a well closed container.

APPLICATION

Dilution: For general washing, dilute 1 part of Saman Deck Wash with 8 parts of water. For heavy cleaning, dilute 1 part of Saman Deck Wash with 3 parts of water.

- 1. Wear chemical resistant gloves, safety goggles and protective clothing.
- 2. Cover areas you want to protect. Thoroughly wet plants and shrubs.
- 3. Apply between 10 °C and 27 °C. Do not apply on a hot surface; product will dry too quickly.
- 4. Plan the application: for horizontal surfaces, work backwards so you do not walk on the surfaces being treated. For vertical surfaces, work from bottom to top.
- 5. Pour Saman Deck Wash into a plastic bucket. Do not use a metal container.
- 6. Apply with a synthetic bristle brush or roller, no more than 20 sq. ft. area at a time to maintain adequate surface wetness and allow best results.
- 7. Leave to work 10-15 minutes. For best results, lightly scrub surface with a broom or stiff bristle brush.
- Rinse thoroughly the surface with a garden hose or pressure washer (max. 3,400 kPa 500 lb/in²), removing all residues.
- 9. If stubborn areas remain, repeat the application in those areas.

For a safe and correct use, read safety data sheet before handling the product.
